Pastors' Peace

In the 14th century, a woman we call Julian of Norwich received a series of profound visions during a time of personal illness and national turmoil. She recorded her visions in a text we now call Revelations of Divine Love. This text is also the earliest work we have of a woman writing in English that has survived to modern day. She is known for understanding God as both Father and Mother.

Julian emphasized the nurturing tendencies of God as akin to motherhood. In Jesus, Julian saw a motherhood expressed through creation, compassion, and continual care—birthing us into life, feeding us with grace, and never abandoning us. She even spoke of communion as Jesus feeding us like mothers nurse their children.

Julian's vision invites us to a more expansive view of God—one that embraces all the ways God loves, heals, and holds us. At a time when people often saw God as distant or angry, Julian's assurance was revolutionary: "As truly as God is our father, so truly is God our mother." Her writings have been used by many teachers - including myself - to show that the idea of God as Mother is not some new-fangled idea from the Women's Rights Movement but has a long history within our faith tradition.

Whatever emotions Mothers' Day brings up for you - and it does bring up a wide variety of emotions - I encourage you to think about God as Mother. God can reflect something you love about your earthly mom. God can provide something your earthly mom didn't. God can be a place of rest from the demands of motherhood. God can mourn with you for your own mom, parent, or child who has passed into Her care. God can lament with you your or others' unfulfilled desire for motherhood. Lift all your prayers to our Heavenly Mother because we know She cares for us. As Julian wrote, "God almighty is our loving father by nature; and God all wisdom is our loving mother by nature."

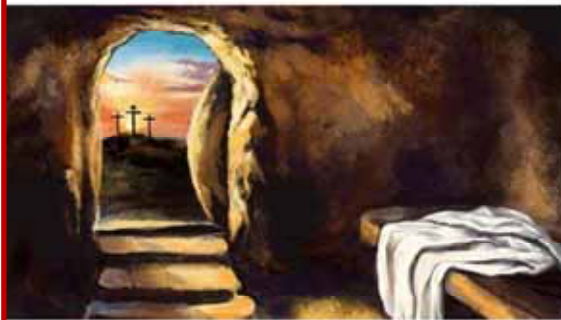

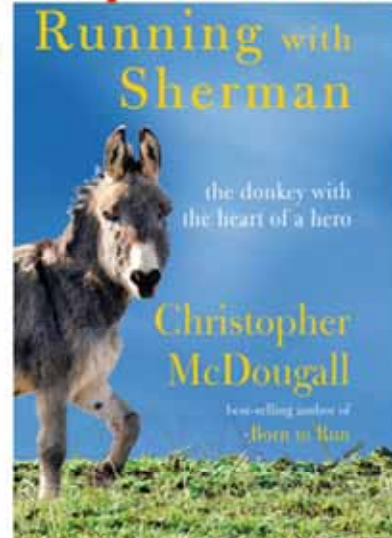
